

Junko Ueda, virtuoso of the *satsuma biwa* (the lute in the "neck of crane"), is especially one of the biggest Japanese singers, a master of the traditional kind *biwa* (epic song) and the Buddhist *shômyô* song. She notably specialized in the interpretation of the works of the Japanese composer Tôru Takemitsu. Junko Ueda studied the *satsuma biwa* with the famous master Kinshi Tsuruta and the Buddhist *shômyô* song with Kôshin Ebihara. Formed in the composition at the Music University of Tokyo, she quickly dedicated itself to the triad of the song and the lute. Her disks of biwa traditional *Heike Monogatari* and *Satsuma Biwa* received numerous prizes, among which Grand Prix of the Disk of the Academy Charles-Cros and cheapest prize of the "Monde la la Musique".


